

## Feeding the Children

Global Outreach Mission is bringing nutritious food to the malnourished children of Sierra Leone. There are a variety of reasons for the lack of proper nutrition - restricted access to safe drinking water, sanitation and quality health services, lack of awareness among mothers on proper child feeding practices. In collaboration with the District Health Authorities, we have set up stabilization centers to treat the most severely malnourished children and mothers with newborns. Recently we have connected with Gleaners in Belleville, Ontario, who have provided us with packaged foodstuffs that will help us bring meals to the children for 25¢ per meal.

As we continue to bring the Gospel in each of these locations, providing food becomes a clear example of delivering the physical caring and loving of Christ. Feeding children opens the door for us to share the love of Jesus. Please join us.

## Clean Water



Unsafe drinking water is the cause of over 3.5 million deaths each year. We are working to make clean drinking water accessible for villagers in Sierra Leone by developing wells. If you feel led to train and educate people in life saving health practices, then we could use you as a member of our Clean Water Project. ## Medical

In a country (with one of the highest infant mortality rates in the world) of 6 million inhabitants and only an estimated 200 physicians, poor health is a huge threat. The life expectancy in Sierra Leone is 42 years and people are in desperate need of care—both medically and spiritually.



Short Term teams are always looking for Medical Professionals to work with National Health workers in primitive Medical settings. There are also opportunities for Career/ Encounter teams/individuals for the establishment of a local Medical Clinic.

## Schools



We need elementary, middle, and high school teachers and vocational trainers. If you would be interested in teaching or training others, this may be the opportunity for you!

## Pastoral Training



We have already established over 50 churches but there is a great need for trained Pastors to lead these new groups of believers. We are training local Christians to take up the role of leaders. Bible teachers are needed.

## Church Planting/Evangelism



Every time we open a new well, we strive to open a new church as well. Leading these wonderful people to Christ has been a blessing but leading them to a lifetime

relationship with Jesus is the most important task. We need people to reach out to individuals and small groups to share the love of Jesus.

## Construction



Our goal is to see every village have clean water, sufficient schools for every child, and a church. To grow these and to keep them running we need skilled and not-so-skilled workers to build and maintain churches, schools, and medical clinics.
