Current Needs

Belize: Construction workers to build a dental clinic in Independence. A Dentist and Assistants for the dental clinic. Pastors to train national pastors who have little biblical knowledge and youth workers to help with a growing ministry.

Brazil: Teaching the children of missionaries to free them up to reach out to the abandoned children of the natives living along the Amazon River. The family of seven serves in Manaus.



Costa Rica: El Jardín Sagrado, the GOM retreat center in the Orosi Valley is looking for a camp nurse or physician assistant to help with the medical ministry. An accountant is also needed for the center. Pastoral trainers and church planters will find ample work in Costa Rica.

Dominican Republic: Teachers are needed for a primary school. Construction workers are needed to complete a church building and a school.

England: Pastors are needed for small congregations that are unable to support a full time pastor. Friendship evangelism.

France: New workers are needed to replace retiring missionaries to be involved in evangelism, media ministry, literature distribution, pastoring churches, and church planting. A recording technician and station manager for an evangelical Christian radio organization located in Marseilles. Host couple is needed for a retreat Bible Center in Maubourguet (Hautes Pyrenees)

Germany: Opportunities for ministry are unlimited—church planting, camp work, teaching in short term Bible schools, children's ministry, working alongside national churches, personal evangelism and literature distribution.

Haiti: Career missionaries for evangelism, Bible teaching, church planting and to train nationals in church planting. Teachers for a Christian based school. Hospital Administrator for a new hospital/clinic.



Honduras: Christian medical/dental personnel with a knowledge of Spanish for both short term and career assignments in clinic settings. A hospital requires medical professionals, doctors, nurses, dentists for long term assignments. Teachers to provide biblical training for pastors and Christian workers, elementary school teachers to teach basic subjects and basic hygiene.



India: Opportunities for ministry are varied—church planting, radio broadcasting, team evangelism, youth and children's ministry, Bible teachers for training centers, medical personnel to work with national doctors, pastoral ministry in church settings, Global Health Services has worked with Project Christ International in medical camps among the tribes, in evangelism and for the training of pastors.

Ireland: Career minded missionaries to serve alongside churches and fellow missionaries in evangelism and pastoral care. Friendship evangelism.

Jamaica: Down to earth evangelism for people with the gifts of helps, helping to repair houses with broken fixtures and homes with broken lives. Film evangelism is quite effective in Jamaica.

Middle East: Teaching English as a second language to those interested creates many open doors. Veterinarians could have a unique ministry to the Bedouin community.



Nepal: We have requests for community development personnel, medical workers and Bible school teachers

Curacao: A male counselor would be an asset to the ministry of our local missionary in Curacao.

Peru: Spanish speaking children's workers and evangelists to assist our national worker in Lima.

Republic of Congo: The Pioneer Christian Hospital in Impfondo has a critical need for the following French speaking personnel: Medical: General Surgeon, Primary Care Physician, Missionary Nurses (RN, NP or PA), Obstetric Nurses or Midwives, Pharmacist or Pharmacy assistant. We need people who have completed their training and have relevant experience. We are also launching a Radio ministry and are in need of people with some radio experience.

Sierra Leone: GOM is rebuilding a hospital in Mokanji that requires construction workers, a general surgeon, doctors, nurses and a hospital administrator. Teachers for the many grade schools under Global and to assist in the Bible institute. Church planters to work with those reached through the schools and medical ministries.



Thailand: Minister alongside missionaries at Hope House, a school for children and at a daycare school in Karen village. Provide basic care, teaching, especially basic English. Medical help is also needed. Agricultural training would benefit this farming area as well.

Ukraine: Work alongside established national workers to assist in evangelism and church growth.
