IMMEDIATE NEEDS

The country of Sierra Leone was devastated by a Civil War that lasted over ten years and ended in 2002. The war displaced half of the population and ruined the country's infrastructure. After the war Sierra Leoneans made their way back home to find their villages shattered and in urgent need of repair. Today, 70% of the population live below the poverty level and life expectancy is just 42 years. The mortality rate for mothers is the highest in the world and nearly 1/3 of all children born alive never reach the age of five.

Global Outreach Mission has been ministering in the country of Sierra Leone and has planted over 50 churches and has influence in over 14 Christian schools, drilling over 100 deep, clean water wells and rebuilding a hospital. We want to help the people of Sierra Leone rebuild their lives and to look forward to a better future. The greatest need, which continues to be the most urgent, is clean water.

In rural areas in particular, much of the population has no option but to drink from streams, contaminated by animal and human waste. Diarrhea is now the second largest killer of children under five, second only to malaria.



When children are sick they cannot attend school regularly. Dr. Brian Albrecht, President of Global Outreach Mission said, "When I visit the villages in



Sierra Leone and ask the people what they need more than anything else, their answer is always pure water. The villages have hand dug wells which are about 25 feet deep and run dry during the dry season."

The women and children have to go to the nearest stream, which is contaminated by animals, humans, and this is where all the people bathe and do their laundry.

They fill their buckets with the contaminated water and walk long distances back to the village.



THE PLAN

The Global Outreach Mission Clean Water Project focuses on integrated water and sanitation programs. We have sent well-drilling equipment to Sierra Leone and have trained some of the nationals to run and maintain the equipment.

This will enable the production of clean water wells in each village. We are planning to have our pastors and Christian teachers conduct health education within the communities and promote the use of latrines.

The Global Outreach Mission Clean Water Project : We drill the wells, develop community water companies, and teach health education in the name of Christ.

We are trusting individuals to make this project a sustainable outreach where the water companies will become self-sufficient and will continue to produce clean water in the years to come.
